Advisory group for young people who have learning disabilities and/or are autistic

The Council for Disabled Children (CDC) are a children's charity based in London. We are looking for members for a new national Young People's Advisory Group of young people aged 14-20 to support our work on an important project until March 2024.

What is the project about?

The project is about Keyworkers. Keyworkers make sure that children and young people with a learning disability and/or who are autistic, receive the mental health treatment they need.

CDC will be working with young people and their families/carers to find out about their experiences of having a Keyworker.

Who can join?

We need the help of young people aged 14-20 who have a learning disability and/or are autistic

We need young people who are interested in, or have experience of mental health care.

We need young people who are interested in sharing their views and opinions to help us plan our work with other young people on the project.

What will the group do?

The group will meet online up to 10 times between October 2022 and March 2024.

The group will share their ideas and opinions on any questions CDC have about the project. The group might help with:

- making inclusive activities for young people
- making information accessible
- make films or documents for young people
- plan sessions and interviews for young people.
