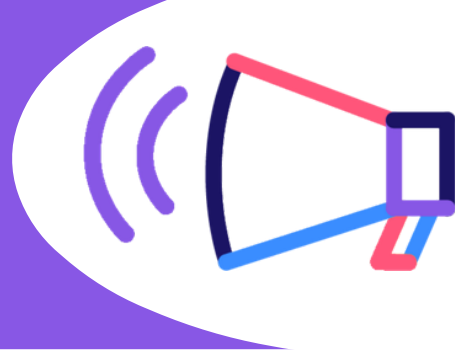


Have your say on the SEND Reforms!



SEND Reform Consultation

The Government has shared some ideas for improving support for children and young people to learn and they want to know what you think.



The Council for Disabled Children (CDC)

CDC is a children's charity that champions the rights of disabled children and young people and their families. We are working with the Government to find out what you think about the SEND reforms.



What? When? Where?

- CDC wants to come and speak with your group of young people.
- CDC will ask you what you think about the Government's ideas for supporting disabled children and young people, and those with a special educational needs to learn.
- The focus groups will happen start in March and finish by the 30th of April.
- The focus groups can be can be online or in-person, CDC will come to you!
- Each focus group will last for up to 1 hour.
- Each person who takes part and shares their thoughts in a session run by CDC will receive a £20 voucher.

This is a great opportunity to get your voice heard by the Government on what works well and what doesn't. Your opinions can help to improve education and support for young people like you!
